MARCOPOLO S.A. (BM&FBovespa: POMO3, POMO4), a leading Brazilian company in bus body production, informs that yesterday New Flyer Industries Inc., a company in which Marcopolo owns 19.97% stake, has signed an agreement to acquire Motor Coach Industries International, Inc. - MCI, North America's largest coach manufacturer, for US\$ 455 million.

About New Flyer

New Flyer Industries Inc. is the leading manufacturer of heavy-duty transit buses in the United States and Canada. The Company is the industry technology leader and offers the broadest product line of transit buses including drive systems powered by clean diesel, natural gas, diesel-electric hybrid and electric.

From January to September, NFI's total revenue was US\$ 1.1 billion, from deliveries of 1,791 new buses and aftermarket parts.

The New Flyer group of companies employ over 3,300 team members with manufacturing, fabrication, parts distribution and service centers in both Canada and the United States. Over 40,000 New Flyer, Orion and NABI heavy-duty transit buses are in operation today.

About MCI

Founded in 1933 in Winnipeg Manitoba, MCI has three manufacturing facilities and nine service and parts distribution centers. The Company is well known in the industry for best-in-class quality, reliability, lowest cost of ownership and a robust aftermarket parts and services offering.

From January to September, MCI's total revenue was US\$ 443 million, from deliveries of 576 new coaches and from pre-owned coach and aftermarket parts.

The location of MCI factories is aligned with the New Flyer's units in the United States and Canada, which will facilitate the synergy gains.
